An awareness programme on 'Preventive Behaviour Around Stray Dogs on Campus' was organized at Government Degree College, Yerraguntla to educate students about safe and responsible interaction with stray animals. The programme aimed to promote awareness on preventing dog bites while encouraging humane treatment of animals.

Faculty members explained the common reasons why stray dogs may become aggressive and advised students to remain calm, avoid teasing or provoking dogs, and refrain from disturbing them while they are eating, sleeping, or caring for puppies. Students were also instructed not to run when approached by a stray dog, to report aggressive animal behaviour to the college authorities, and to seek immediate medical attention in case of a bite or scratch.

The session emphasized maintaining campus cleanliness to reduce food waste that attracts stray animals. The programme concluded with an interactive discussion, reinforcing the importance of responsible behaviour, personal safety, and compassion toward animals, thereby contributing to a safer and more harmonious campus environment.
